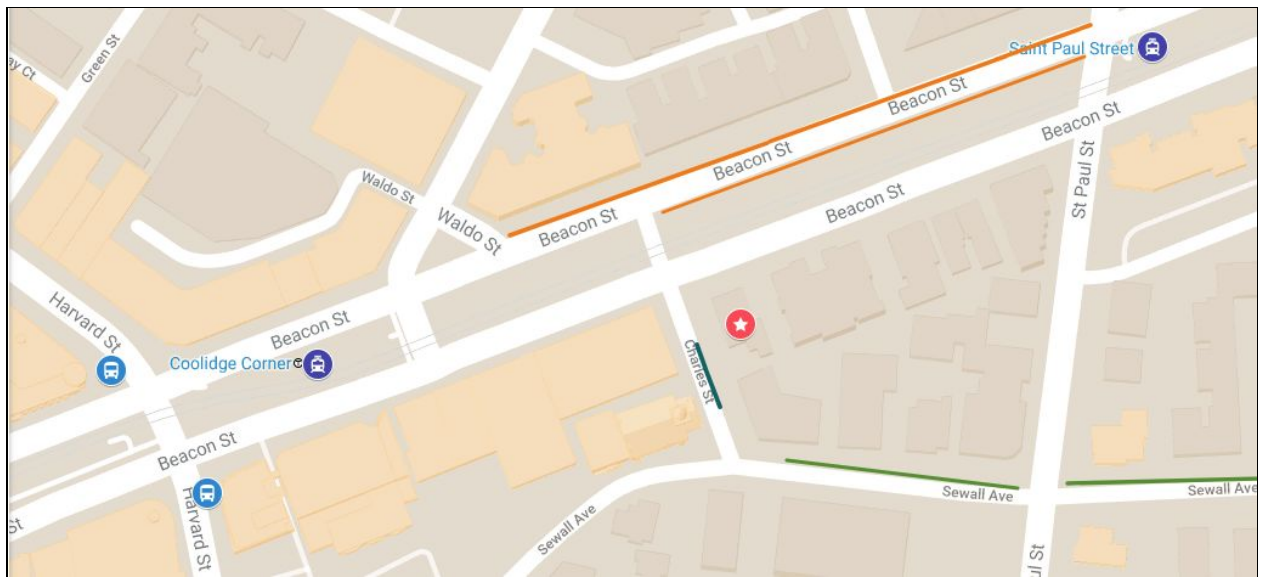












Hello and welcome to The Trauma Center. This document is intended to help guide you to our center. Please feel free to call our main office at 617-232-1303 with any additional questions.

### **Parking**

Metered street parking is available on Beacon Street. Additionally, free street parking is available after 10:00 AM on Sewall Avenue. Please note, the parking lot at the Trauma Center and the garage on Charles Street are both closed to public access.

### **Public Transportation**

The Trauma Center is nearby to the Green C Line and located between the Coolidge Corner and St. Paul Street stops. The 66 bus also stops at the corner of Beacon Street and Harvard Avenue and provides access to Cambridge, Allston, Roxbury, and connections to the Red and Orange Lines.

### **Accessibility**

Entry to our office is accessible via stairs or ramps. Within the building there are elevators as well as stairs to access the basement and second floor levels of the clinic. Reserved accessible parking is available on Charles Street, Beacon Street, and Sewall Ave.

### **Arriving to your appointment**

The Trauma Center is located in a beige Victorian building on the corner of Beacon Street and Charles Street. There is a large wooden sign on the corner that says “1269 Beacon Street.” Enter the building through the ramp or stairs on the Charles Street side of the building. After passing through the outside door and entering the vestibule, you will see our waiting room to your left.

Upon entering the waiting room, you will see a phone mounted on the wall near the door into the clinic. Next to the phone is a list of Trauma Center clinicians and their extensions. Please dial your clinician and let them know you have arrived. Please leave a message for your clinician if they do not pick up. Your clinician will meet you in the waiting room at the start of your appointment.

If you would like to use the bathroom or get a drink of water, please ring the doorbell near the phone and someone will buzz you in. Note, the Trauma Center does not have a receptionist to check in with upon arrival.
