MBHC is accepting applications for a 2-year Postdoctoral Fellowship (start date on or before 9/1/12). The clinician will receive outstanding supervision, ongoing clinical training (including training through the Trauma Center at JRI), and competitive compensation. A minimum of 16 hours of direct clinical service is required per week, reimbursed on a fee-for-service basis. Part-and full-time options are available; the position qualifies for benefits. Clinicians must be available to see clients between the hours of 2pm-8pm three days per week and must be available to attend our weekly team and didactic training series on Fridays from 10-12. Hiring priorities will be based on training/experience in any of the aforementioned specialties. While applicants may see all ages of clients, the successful applicant will have significant experience with child and family therapy.
