Program Description

The Trauma Center at JRI is currently looking to fill several part to full-time clinical research positions (20 to 40 hours per week) involving conducting clinical research evaluations and other study duties for an intervention study. Position to begin February or March 2018. The Trauma Center at JRI is an internationally recognized non-profit organization that has been involved in training, treatment outcome research and service delivery with trauma impacted populations for over 30 years. This position will include responsibilities on the Trauma Center's randomized control trial examining the efficacy of Attachment, Regulation and Competency (ARC) for treating mental health symptoms among children ages 8 to 16 who have experienced multiple traumatic exposures.

Job Description:

Essential job functions for this position include, 1) Conducting phone screens of potential research participants, 2) Conducting study evaluations, 3) Entry and management of clinical outcome data in excell, 4) Administrative support as needed, and 5) Participation in weekly project meetings with other members of the research team. Travel within Eastern Massachusetts will be required as all study evaluations will be conducted at off site community based mental health clinics where the intervention is being delivered.

Requirements:

Relevant skills and experience include; B.A., B.S. or Master's degree in psychology or other related field, prior research experience, experience in clinical interviewing, excellent organizational and process management skills, excellent oral communication and interpersonal skills, ability to work collaboratively with a multi-disciplinary team, self-motivated/takes initiative, creative thinker with the flexibility to adapt to the challenges of working with trauma-impacted children and families. Background in traumatic stress is preferred. Applicants must own their own vehicle.
